Visa application

Family unit members may apply to accompany and stay with the occupational trainee in Australia if they are:

§ the trainee's spouse

§ dependent child of the trainee or trainee's spouse who are under 18 years of age, unless reasons for continued dependence can be shown; or

§ other close relatives living with the trainee who are dependent on the trainee and can show valid reasons for dependence.

Nomination approval does not guarantee the visa application will also be approved. Your nominee will need to satisfy a number of requirements before a visa can be issued.

Please ensure your nominee receives a copy of this letter (a faxed copy is acceptable), which they should lodge with their visa application at their nearest Australian Immigration office.
